#### OUR FATHER IN HEAVEN, HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME.

- **God's name to be lifted up //** For people everywhere to see Jesus as Lord and Saviour and to worship him.
- **The Church //** For churches to be filled with the Holy Spirit and to love and serve their communities always pointing to Jesus.
- For the Kingdom // For God's Kingdom to come and his will to be done.

### GIVE US TODAY OUR DAILY BREAD. FORGIVE US OUR SINS AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO SIN AGAINST US.

- God's provision and comfort // For the vulnerable, isolated, bereaved and those in any kind of need.
- **Reconciliation and forgiveness** // For church unity. For the good news of Jesus to be shared bringing reconciliation and healing. For damaged relationships to be restored.

### LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL.

• **Freedom found in Jesus //** Freedom from the things that hold us captive e.g. addiction, fear, negative thought patterns, lies. Freedom from pain, sorrow, brokenness & darkness. For people to know God's peace.

### FOR THE KINGDOM, THE POWER, AND THE GLORY ARE YOURS NOW AND FOREVER. AMEN.

- The rule and reign of God // For us to be full of faith that Jesus is the light that no darkness can extinguish.
- The expansion of God's Kingdom // Thankfulness for where we see God moving and prayer for where we are yet to see his Kingdom come.
- The light of Jesus to shine // For our lives and our churches to be beacons of light reflecting Jesus' light and glory.
